Rapid Assessment (Windshield) Procedures and Documents

Safety:

- Do not place yourself in danger while traveling to conduct your survey**
- Report immediately if you are injured or potentially in danger**
- Do not enter a building to conduct assessments during the Rapid Assessment**
- Do not render assistance unless life safety is threatened**

Necessary tools:

- Radio Communications
- Flashlight
- Rapid Assessment Forms and Sector Maps
- List of Priority 1 and 2 Facilities/Infrastructure for Assigned Sector

Instructions:

1. Upon direction, or following a major earthquake in Kitsap County, conduct a sector survey of life safety and damage using the following guidelines:

- Conduct your survey expeditiously, concentrating on Priority 1 items, then Priority 2.
- For life safety, contact 9-1-1 immediately, but do not render assistance unless there is potential for significant threat to life.
- For Priority 1 **significant** facility damage call your city/county EOC immediately.

2. If there is no damage to report, continue your survey until it is complete. Then call in reporting on your entire sector.

3. If you are unable to radio your report to 9-1-1/county/city EOC, report to the nearest fire station and report via available radio communications.

4. Observe and note other major issues while conducting your assessment. Use your judgment on whether an issue is significant and should be reported.

5. Use the phone numbers and frequencies on the reverse to make your reports.

**Rapid Assessment
Field “Windshield Survey”
Checklist**

- While enroute, observe and note damage to roadways and major arterials.
- Observe and note significant damage to other facilities not on your list.
- Call 9-1-1 Dispatch immediately for any life safety issues. Do not provide assistance unless the potential for loss of life is imminent
- For Priority 1 and 2 Facilities, review the list below as you observe the condition to the facilities and surrounding areas. Note your observations in the sections found on the reverse side of this form.

Building Structure

- Collapsed, partial collapse, no damage,
- Need of Search and rescue
- Personnel evacuated
- Walking wounded, injured
- Resource damages (autos, fire trucks, etc...)
- Access to the facility

Other Hazards

- Ground or waterborne hazardous materials
- Uncontrolled fires
- Flooding

Utilities

- Water
- Sewer
- Electrical
- Gas

Roads

- Not passable
- Lanes closed
- Overpass down blocking road
- Trees, power lines blocking road
- Motor vehicle accidents
- Bridges collapsed or blocked
