

# QUARANTINE AND ISOLATION SITE VOLUNTEER INVITATION

Thank you for your interest in volunteering to staff the quarantine/isolation site for individuals in Kitsap County who have been exposed to or tested positive for COVID-19 and lack alternative housing solutions. This site is designated as non-medical and voluntary for people experiencing homelessness or wanting to protect household members from infection. Guests must be referred to the site by a healthcare provider or public health official.

This site is maintained and managed by Kitsap County Department of Emergency Management (KCDEM) as a key tool in the local battle against the spread of COVID-19. Examples of volunteer staff duties include delivering boxed meals to guests, processing intake forms upon guests' arrival, taking patients' temperatures using a no-touch thermometer, delivering clean laundry to guests, donning and doffing of personal protective equipment (PPE).

Security is always on-site. No volunteers will work alone. Environmental services are contracted to provide cleaning services. CDC-recommended PPE and comprehensive training will be provided for all volunteers. All guests will be self-sufficient and not require assistance with activities of daily living. Staffing will be needed 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, during times when the site is open.

We are requesting volunteers to sign up in advance for designated shifts and be available to staff the site when notified of activation. To help fill this vital need, please click this [link](#) to fill out an application to volunteer as a disaster emergency worker.
